



Title: The Baggage Handler Text: John 20-21

- 1. Read through John 20-21 and ask yourself, "Who do I identify most with in these two chapters and why? Mary Magdalene? Simon Peter? John? Thomas? Other disciples?"

- 3. What would you say are other "baggage" issues you struggle with in life that may not be addressed directly in this passage? If you are in a small group of people who know you well, how about asking them to share with you what they may see as additional "baggage" in your life from which Christ wants to free you?
- 4. Encountering the resurrected Lord Jesus helped every one of these biblical people let go of their "baggage." Why do you think Christ's resurrection had that powerful effect on them? In what ways could true belief in Jesus' resurrection enable you to let go of past and present "baggage" issues?
- 5. Of all the questions and responses Jesus gave to his followers in these two post-resurrection chapters, which one or two do you think apply most to you? Why?
- 6. Where would you like to see the resurrection power of Jesus Christ at work in your own experience this week?
